The venue hasn't changed much since 2005 when Marty Umanoff proposed the idea, and these live outdoor concerts have been a favorite summer activity every since!

Concerts are held in the parking lot of the Hershey's Mill Golf Club, and the concerts backdrop is the beautiful line of trees along a fairway - with even more trees all around. The paved lot makes for easy walking, and there is still space in the lot for cars (which makes it close and convenient). Since we provide chairs, all you have to bring is yourself; although, we recommend you bring your dancing shoes as well, since all three bands will have you on your feet with your friends and neighbors!

To make it even more of an event, and to give yourself a true "evening out", why not have dinner at the Golf Club before the concerts? This makes it easy to park just once, but have two great activities; of course, golf carts or a walk through our beautiful community will get you there as well.

Every year we evaluate the prior year's concerts to determine if the formats, quality, and attendance warrant changes. We were particularly pleased with the 2016 concert performances, and are bringing back the same great bands! With a mix of big band, jazz, oldies, and other favorites, we seem to have hit the "sweet spot" that Mill residents enjoy - and with attendance of 300 to 400, something special for nearly everyone.

The cost of putting on the concerts is paid for by Hershey's Mill Community-TV; however, this is partially offset by our individual concert sponsors - we thank them all! Of course, these concerts couldn't happen without the help of our wonderful HMC-TV behind-the-scenes volunteers, as well as those you see handing out programs, setting up and taking down chairs and signs, etc. Also, we tape each concert and replay them on Channel 20 TV later in the year.
